Dear Senator _____,

The House of Representatives passed H.R. 1996 – the Secure and Fair Enforcement (SAFE) Banking Act more than a year ago and it's critical that the Senate act now before the summer recess. SAFE is landmark legislation to reform federal cannabis laws and reduce the public safety risk in communities across the country by allowing cannabis-related businesses in states with some form of legalized cannabis and strict regulatory structures to access to the banking system.

I'm a (insert state here) voter, and I'm calling for positive and productive steps forward to bring regulated cannabis more fully into the United States banking system. I urge you to support the SAFE Act. Please reach out to Senate leadership and insist that they bring this measure to the Senate floor for a vote. According to a recent Pew Research Center poll, 91% of Americans agree that cannabis should be legal for adults. Adult use cannabis is legal in 18 states and 39 states have legalized cannabis for medical use. The people have spoken, and it is time for the federal government to align itself with the will of the electorate.

The Secure and Fair Enforcement (SAFE) Banking Act creates a framework for safe, regulated financial transactions for the cannabis industry in legal, regulated states. It allows access to the banking system, integrates the regulated cannabis industry into the U.S. economy, deters crimes linked to an all-cash industry, and provides opportunities for legitimate businesses to thrive.

Please act now to support a safe, fair, and regulated cannabis industry.
